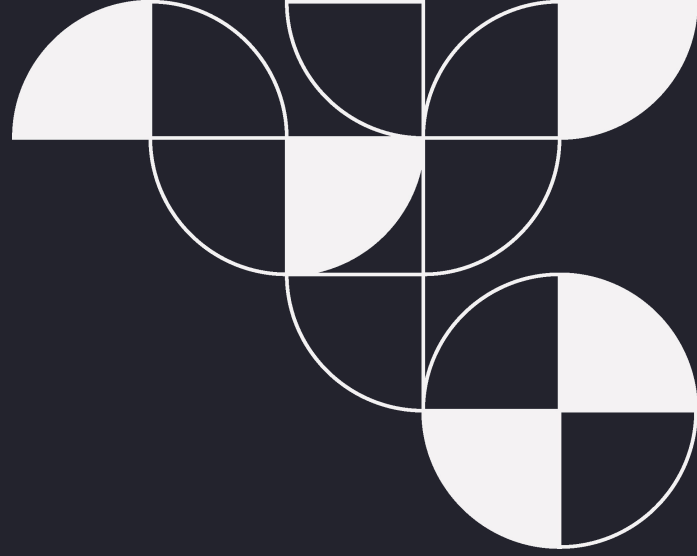

But what if we don't yet fully know **how** to collaborate effectively in a context of complexity, uncertainty, and polarization?




Radical collaboration is an approach to collaboration that goes beyond conventional visioning and planning.

It involves addressing issues at their root. It involves **experimenting** your way forward when you can't clearly see the path ahead.

It involves taking **responsibility** for your role in both the solution and the problem.



# Course Overview

## What's the course about?

This two-day course is designed to deepen participants' capacity to collaborate with diverse stakeholders to address complex societal challenges.

The course is structured around developing and enhancing collaborative capabilities, processes, and spaces. Participants will leave with new understanding of how to approach systemic collaboration to achieve impactful and durable outcomes.

- Committed leaders from different sectors who want to explore a new way to tackle complex issues and do it with diverse stakeholders.
- Change agents who want to learn to support groups to move past blockages and bridge collaboration gaps to transform systems.

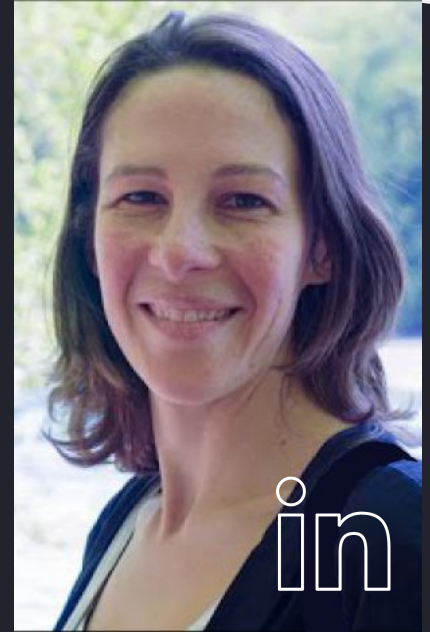


# Course Facilitators
